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Interviewer: Modern people tend to spend more time online. We replace real meetings with video chats and devote an enormous amount of time to social media. Besides, online education ^{has} gained popularity among students. My guest today is Hermione Granger who features in a series of books about Harry Potter by J.K. Rowling. The author represents modern literature. My guest is an example of a teenager of the 21st century. Hermione, do you think that online education is beneficial for young people?

Hermione: Firstly, I used to be a diligent student in Hogwarts so I know how difficult it can be to study without anyone's help and support. I was lucky to always have my loyal friends by my side. However, people who study online might feel lonely and deprived of attention, which can negatively affect their mental state.

Secondly, the level of online education is not high enough to replace real schools and universities. Despite the fact that we cannot fully transfer our educational system into online, I support the usage of various Internet sources for learning. It is a perfect way for students to quickly find information. When I was in Hogwarts I could spend days checking the books in the library to find necessary details for my home assignments.

Interviewer: What do you think about the fact that young people replace offline activities with spending time using social media or playing videogames?

Hermione: I understand everyone's concern about teenagers being glued to their phones and computers. It can lead to serious consequences. The lack of physical activity makes people weaker and more easily influenced by diseases. Also, social media cannot replace face-to-face communication. Teenagers who spend a lot of time online tend to feel more depressed and lonely.

Interviewer: What is your opinion on prospects of this trend?

Hermione: I think that digital technologies are ^{numbux 3} going to be developed. It will give people a lot of new opportunities. However, we cannot fully replace real life with online activities. I believe that maintaining balance between online and offline is the best solution for all of us.

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
