To summarise, abstaining from using planes is not practical. Instead, people should come to a compromise to not release as much emissions in a different way.

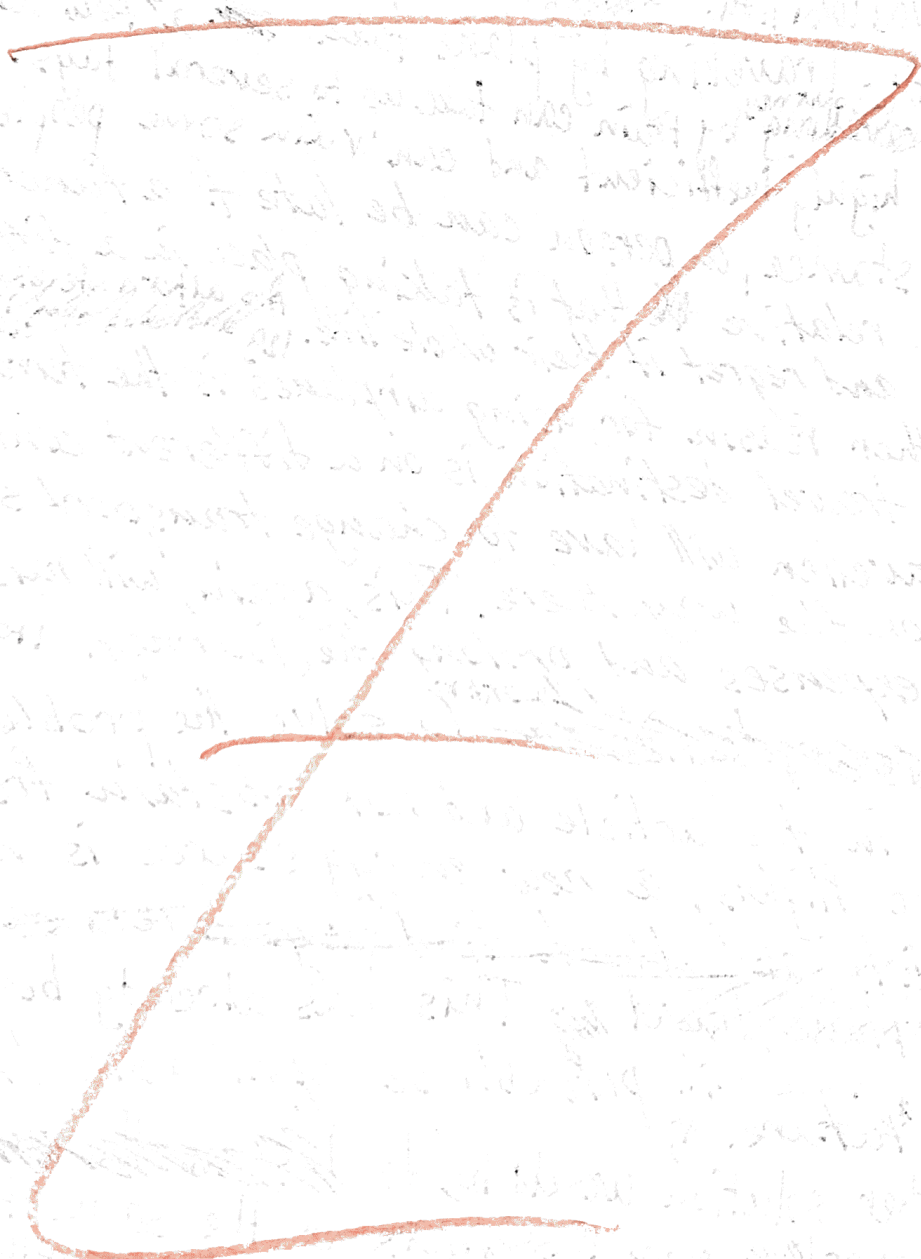
