

For example, they might not like the story telling part, as they ²⁷⁰ have probably read ²⁷⁵ Greek myths in school already. On the other hand, bed time at midnight would make younger children exhausted. Most of the kids their age go to sleep at 8-9 pm, so staying up late could be hard for them. That's why I think that it's not suitable for ²⁸⁰ these age limits. ³⁶⁰
~~if we do not pay attention to the age, then I have almost no problems with the organisation of the event. Kids usually need 8-10 hours of sleep daily but after this sleepover they will get only 3. More than that, the film 300 Spartans is definitely not for young audience. Snack break at 9 pm is not good for health, too, as the doctors say that you shouldn't eat anything heavy with calories for 4 hours before the bedtime, but overall the sleepover is not that bad.~~

I would like to present my own museum event. It is held in the Arzov Museum, which is one of the most famous paleontological museums in Russia. The museum has an all-year exhibition of the gold of the ancient nations, who lived here before such as Skifs. The event is called "The Ancient Treasures", and it is perfect for the kids 7-16yo.
