This analysis will focus on events organised in museums specifically for children, which might act as a solution to the ~~mentioned~~ aforementioned problem, along with providing a possible plan for such an event.

### Analysis of the ~~British Museum's~~ 'Awesome Greece' event

The Awesome Greece event, organised by the British Museum, offers a number of activities connected to the culture of ancient and modern Greece, such as learning to dance traditional dances or listening to ancient Greek legends. Although the event is stated to be for children aged 8-14, ~~the~~ most activities are suitable for older teenagers as well. For example, the film *The 300 Spartans* probably caters to a more adult audience.

However, the presented plan has a number of ~~problems~~ <sup>problems</sup> which mostly arise because of the event's being a sleepover. <sup>For instance,</sup> the activities are planned to end at 23:30 ~~and~~ on Saturday night and breakfast on Sunday ~~is~~ <sup>starts</sup> begins at seven ~~am~~ o'clock, leaving children less than seven and a half hours to sleep. Most ~~and~~ doctors would argue that this amount is not enough, especially for those younger than ten years old. Thus, the organisation of the event is faulty. Furthermore, the tickets are quite expensive which might discourage potential visitors.

Possible event proposal
