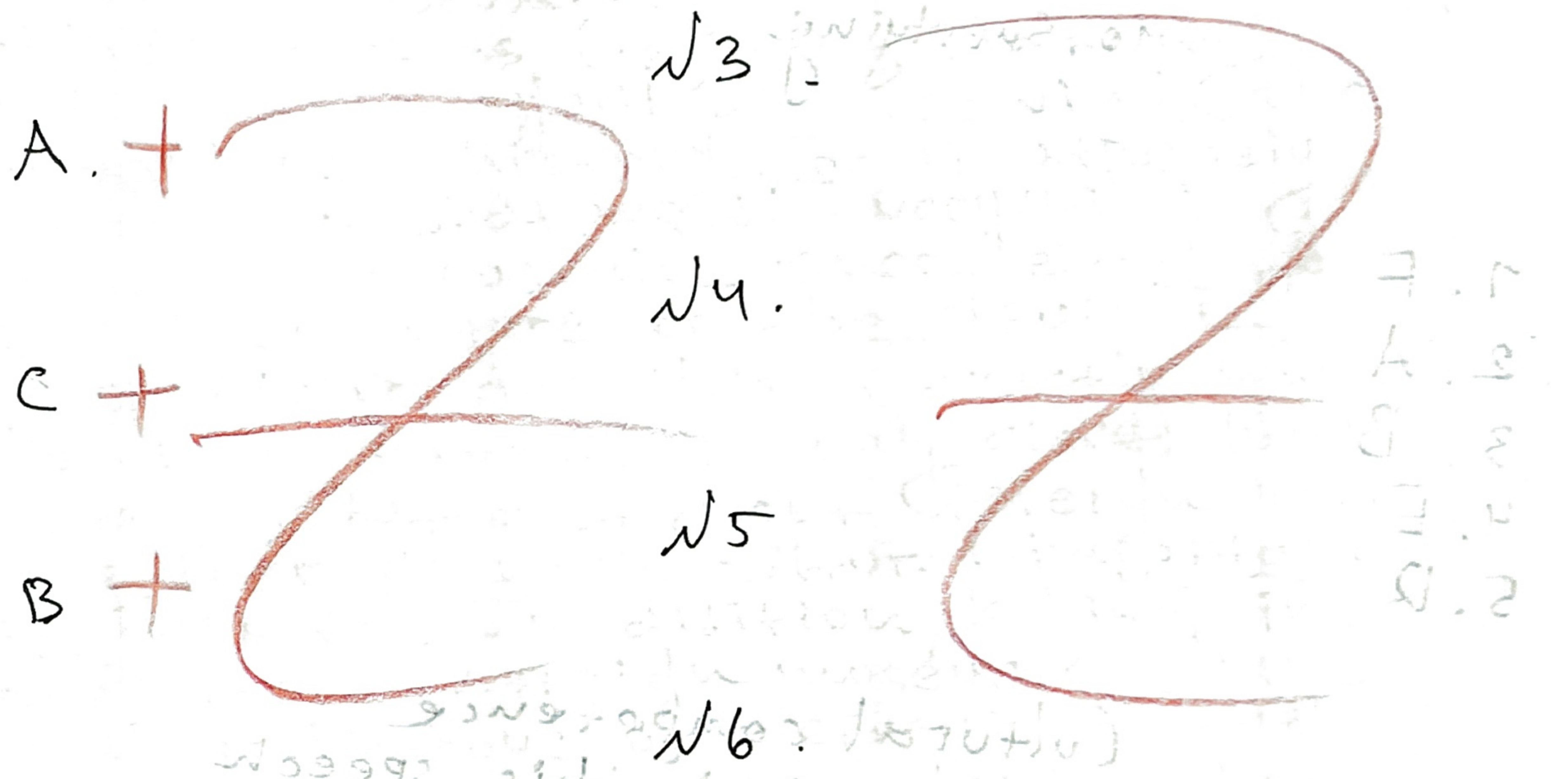

Worth it.

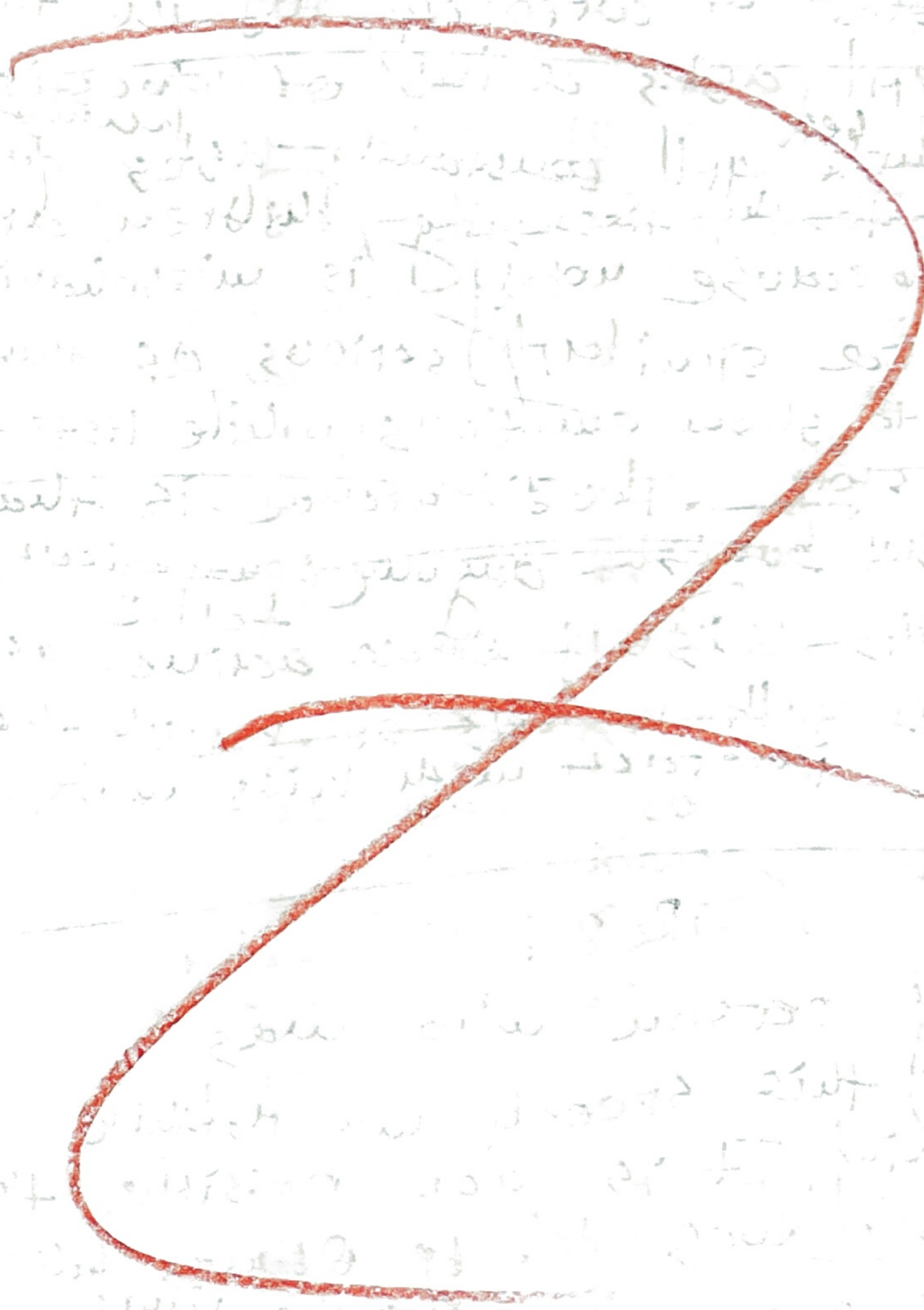
